Division Goals for the year

- Grow membership by supporting existing clubs and clubs in formation.
- Encourage members to participate in Area and Division level contests and workshops.
- Ensure all clubs have resources available for members to use Pathways effectively.

Division Celebrations & Successes

- Mount Victoria and Fearbusters has increased membership since the last report
- Club Leadership Training has concluded with support from two Area Directors in Division H and Pathways resources from Division J Director. 60 club officers trained and non-committee members from Te Aro attended too.
- Area directors have completed 80% of their unofficial visits and have begun liaising with clubs regarding club and area contests.
- A few clubs have already had their first contest(s).

Division Challenges, Issues & Solutions

- A couple of clubs have dropped into the 16-19 tier.
- Membership:
 - < 15 in 19% of the clubs. A few of them have external challenges which will affect their membership. Some have coaches in place already.
 - 16-19 in 30% of the clubs.
 - Area Directors to identify the support they need and the challenges they are facing.
- One club, that was appointed a coach last year, is slowly increasing their membership. They have an energetic committee willing to fill the gaps. However they do not have the Pathways expertise to help new and existing members. With support from the Division Director, the coach will suggest a Pathways session to the committee. On other news, they will hold at least two contests this year, whereas in previous years they would nominate a member.
- Area directors needs to be upskilled in Pathways, in the Base Camp manager side.
- Hold a face to face meeting to demonstrate Pathways, District Central and resolve access to Zoom meetings.
- The first division council is being held in late August and there will be more insight received from the area directors.
- Clubs in formation cannot easily progress into Pathways. Looking into two possible solutions for them.

New Clubs Progress

- KPMG – have submitted their final paperwork and will go into H1.
- GLAM – Division Director has offered support to the sponsors and mentors

- Fearbusters is holding a special event, Public Speaking Stories from the Mayor, on 27th August. It is open to the public to learn about Toastmasters.
