## Status of Areas and Clubs

### Areas

7 areas, 7 Area Directors. AD for G3 has changed.

Area G Council meetings occurring monthly

Area Contest dates being set

Area Director Visit reports. Numbers low as a consequence of avoiding doing them online. Now proceeding.

### Clubs

33 active clubs

3 clubs 12 or less members therefore qualify for coaching

9 clubs 13 - 15 members which may need support

23 clubs do not currently have sufficient members to qualify for DCP

Club Contests under way.

Areas G1 and G4 **and now G5** have 4 clubs so entitled to provide 2 contestants per club to Area contests

Pathways status that can be improved relatively easily:

Number of clubs **with** 100% new members enrolled: 7

Number of clubs **with less than** 100 % club officers enrolled: 8

### Concerns follow on from August report **updates in red for October 2021**

1. There are many emails being sent out at several levels, but few are being annotated with information on which groups they were sent to. Leads to confusion as to who has been told what, and either missed emails or duplicate emails which in turn leads to them not being read. – **update October 2021: Much better, but the communication plan not yet published.**
2. Area G5 has 5 clubs listed by TI and even though one of those clubs is being closed, it counts as having 5 clubs so can only send 1 contestant to area. This not fair. **Resolved 1<sup>st</sup> October.**
3. The DCP membership overriding status switch is in conflict with the new members goals. The new members goals can be met but then they and all other goals are ignored if the club does not have 20 members or a net increase of 5 members because some members leave. This is not a good reflection of reality. Experienced members that could be working with clubs are discouraged by not being able to help achieve any DCP goal and as a consequence decide to leave the club or TM altogether.
4. **Club NZX Wordstock appeared to have ceased operating but when asked to submit dissolution papers decided to revive. Pending resolution by TI WHQ.**
5. **No documentation on D72 standardized processing of Area Director reports but PQD has started process to improve the situation.**
