## Goals

## Areas

1. There are 6 areas within this Division (Area G1, G2, G3, G4, G6, and G7).
2. Two areas (Area G4, and Area G6) are without Area Directors. The advice is for those areas (Area G4 and G6) to work with their clubs to get club and area contests done.   - Area G4 – Wellington Club, Wellington Professional club, Solnet, Te Aro and Capital Clubs
  - Area G6 – LINZ, Toast Now, High Noon Bankers, and Statistically Speaking Toastmasters Clubs
  - Area G7- Cook Strait club, Island Bay Toastmasters, Newtown, Peninsula presenters, and Turbine Talkers club

## Clubs

1. There are 29 clubs in Division G. This is the biggest division in District 72.
2. 10 clubs have 12 or less members and therefore they qualify for club coaching
3. 8 clubs have 13-15 members which means that they might need support
4. 20 clubs in total do not have enough numbers to meet DCP
5. Area G1 and G6 have 4 clubs so they are entitled to provide 2 contestants per club for Area contests.
6. Pathways adoption rate can be improved throughout Division G. 15 clubs have 50% to 100% pathways adoption rate for new members.

The contest date has been set for Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> March 2023. Venue still to be finalised. Exploring two possible venues for the Division Conference.
