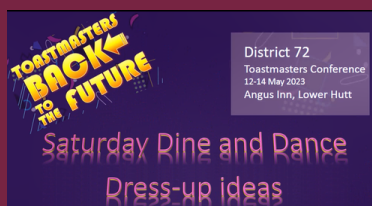

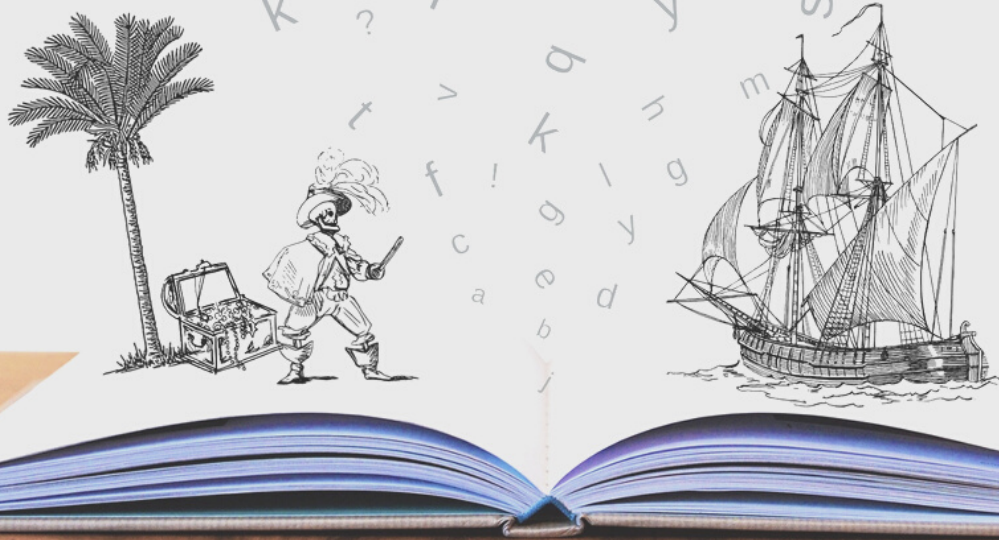
# Pathways Challenge
