Goals:

This year the Division D leadership team wished to focus on assisting Clubs with increasing their membership along with assisting the members with education, along with more in-person connection.

- Membership has sadly decreased, including my own club, but I do note that Club Membership since September dues has been steadily on the rise again.
- An Educational weekend was planned, however, due to lack of interest, it was postponed until the new Toastmasters year.
- It was good to see a good number of people attending the Division D Conference, especially to support their fellow club members.

Dues Renewal & Membership Status:

At the start of the year, District Dashboard showed that the Division D base membership number was 317, with club numbers were showing 18. Although the reality was much different and the base was in fact 16 paid clubs, with 2 clubs already in bad standing, and not intending to renew.

The Division D membership is now down to 246 and we are now at 14 clubs, with a further loss of 2 clubs:

- Avon was able to renew their October dues prior to 31st March, however, as at the 1st April they are back to being a club in Bad Standing. Avon now have a Club Coach and hopefully soon will be paying their April Dues (paying until 30 September 2023).
- Lincoln Research is also a club in Bad standing, as they are taking a 6-month break (hiatus) in order to regroup and see if they will continue as a club.

It might pay to note here, that often Clubs will only renew the minimum number of members to keep the club in good standing. Also, that many clubs will normally lose one-third membership due to natural attrition (people leaving for various reasons: like moving, new jobs, change of circumstances, etc).

This is indicative of a similar situation around other Divisions in District 72 and around other Districts around the world. Clubs are struggling everywhere, with decreased interest in volunteering (keeping clubs running) and affected by the general financial unrest around the world.
