Once the District Executive Committee makes a decision, each Committee Member, regardless of personal point of view, shall support the decision in all communications to members.

Rationale - It is the responsibility of District Executive Committee (DEC) members to actively debate, amend and vote on any matter before it is discussed by the District Council. Once a decision is made by the District Executive Committee it then presented to the District Council "on behalf of the District Executive".

Every DEC member is encouraged to present their personal viewpoint during the DEC meeting, however, once a decision is reached by the majority of the DEC, it is important a united front is presented to the District Council and the membership. If you vote against a decision, please remember you can ask to have your vote recorded in the minutes.

The DEC is the place for District Officers to present their viewpoint, the District Council is the place for Club Presidents and Club Vice-Presidents Education to share their thoughts.

This new procedure replicates Policy 11.0 Board of Directors

Once the Board makes a decision, each Board Member, regardless of personal point of view, shall support the decision in all communications outside the Board.
