

District Elections Update

District 72 is now calling for floor candidates for the following roles:

- Program Quality Director
- Club Growth Director
- Public Relations Manager
- Division Directors (C, D/E, G, J)

Floor Candidate Information

You:

- must be qualified or eligible
- must have signed and submitted the District Leader Agreement and
- Release Statement
- must have informed the <u>District Director</u> of intention to stand by 12 noon, 6 May
- may be nominated for a maximum of two roles.

Further Information

The only situations when floor candidates can run for District election are:

- If a candidate was evaluated by the DLC, but not nominated for a particular role, the candidate may stand for that role
- If the DLC report is incomplete, qualified floor candidates may run for role(s) that have insufficient nominated candidates.

The incoming 2023/24 District Director can appoint qualified members into any unfilled roles after the election.
