COT 1, August 2023


I organized and created the material for COT 1 in August '23. In total, there were six COT sessions. The first five were all online and the last one was in-person and was organized by Division G. (Unfortunately, we haven't established a Training Team as yet, so the content creation and organization of the training fell to me.)

I liaised with District 112 ensure that our officers were able to choose their training instead and a few officers took part in D112 COTs. In total, 322 officers from District 72 were trained. Of 96 clubs, 50% of clubs trained 4 or more officers and achieved a point in the Distinguished Club Program - which is a great result!

All attendees were invited to fill out a feedback form. The results of the 198 attendees who filled out the form were as follows:

(The feedback for both main workshops were amalgamated)

When asked the question: "I learned something that will make me more effective as a Club Officer," the result was: Agree: 114 = 57.5% Strongly agree: 46 =23.2% Neither agree nor not agree: 28 =14.1% Disagree: 2 =1% Strongly disagree: 2 =1%



As you can see from this chart, 80% of COT 1 attendees respondes with '*Agree*' or '*Stongly agree*' to the question: *I learned something that will make me more effective as a Club Officer.* This shows that the COT 1 was successful.
