


Goals:

Division D encompasses a wide region, stretching from the Canterbury Plains to Nelson. The goals of our Division centre around fostering strong bonds between clubs, empowering them to engage in pathways and their success plan, and encouraging membership growth.

Due to the distances involved between some of the Areas it can be difficult for some clubs to stay in touch or build relationships with each other. By supporting joint events and club exchanges (in person and on zoom), we aim to help a sense of community develop – no club is on its own, and the wealth of knowledge and experience many clubs have can be shared for the benefit of all toastmasters.

Membership in Division D is in a good state, with a net increase of between 3-20% occurring in all areas. However, 7 of our 27 clubs are at 12 or below members and will need further support. Running a club at low numbers puts a strain on all members there – our Division Team will make sure that they aren't on their own and receive the support of the district in returning to good health.


