


## Club Membership at a Glance:

Division D has continued to grow since August last year, hitting a high of 512 members as of this month (net growth of 12). Most of this growth has occurred in clubs with 12 or fewer members which is really good to see. Our goal is to encourage these clubs in growing to 16+ members, and also provide support to those who have lost members over the past year.

Division D has also hit the ball out of the park achieving their education goals this past year, with 140+ levels being achieved division wide. This is really encouraging to see, especially with almost 40 members completing their Pathways!







## What's been happening:

Our team ran the Division D COT in January, with over 35 attendees from Div D and also other areas. To better support our club officers, we took a unique approach to running our Officer Workshops – running live QA panels and interactive Podcasts via Zoom.

This proved to be very effective (and popular), with nearly all attendees taking part until the end as well as contributing to the workshops. The workshop coordinators were: Peter and Reuben from UCanSpeak, Jude and Lachlan from Madhatters Toastmasters.
