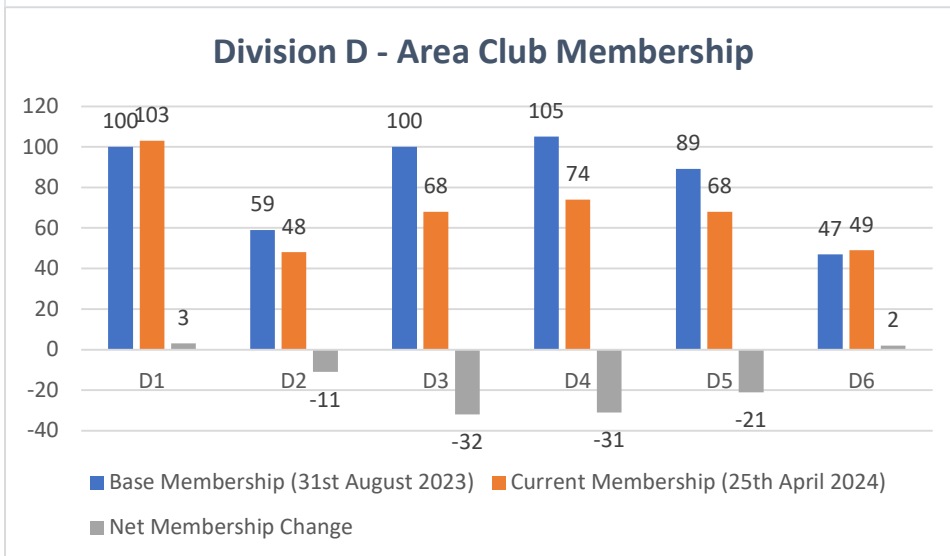
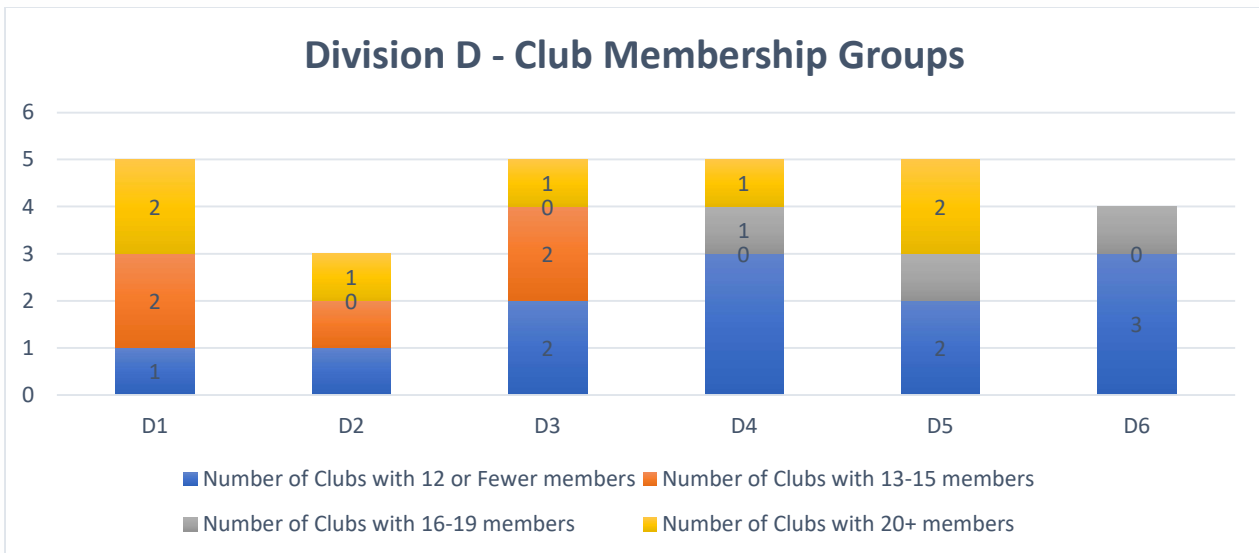

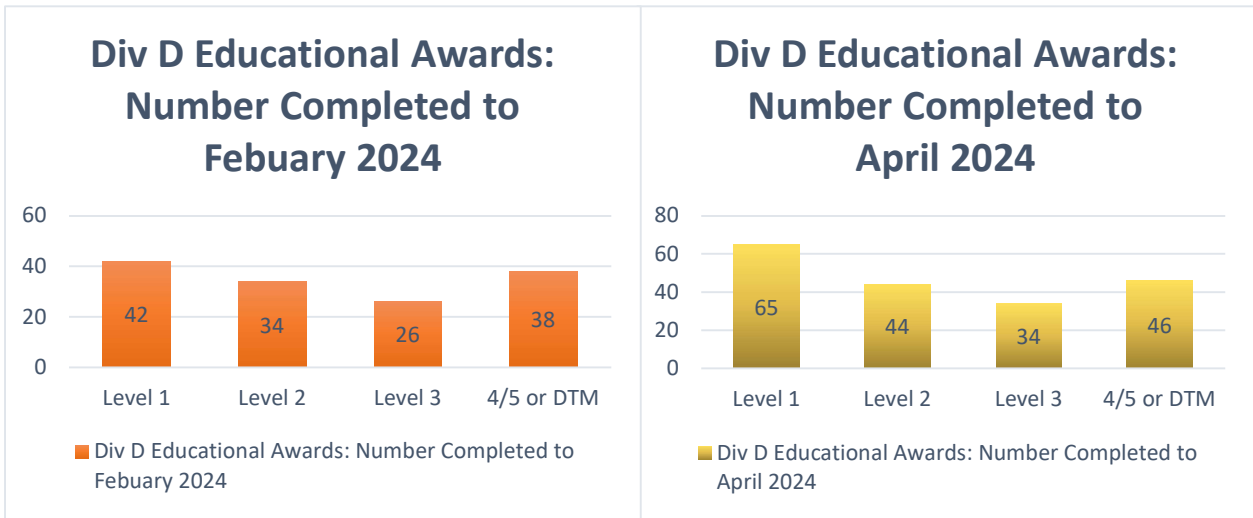
Club Membership at a Glance:
