### Club Membership and status at a glance:

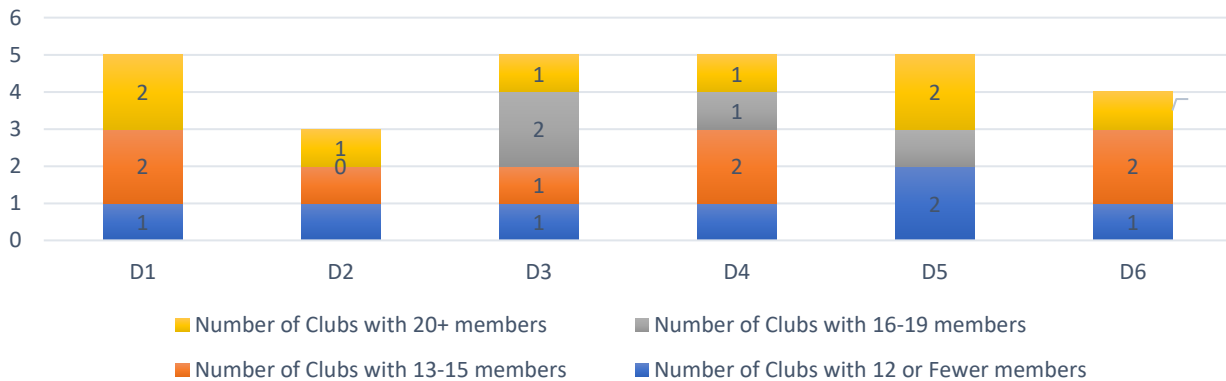

Contributing factors to the reductions include the membership fee hikes, club closures, and governmental cuts for industry based clubs.

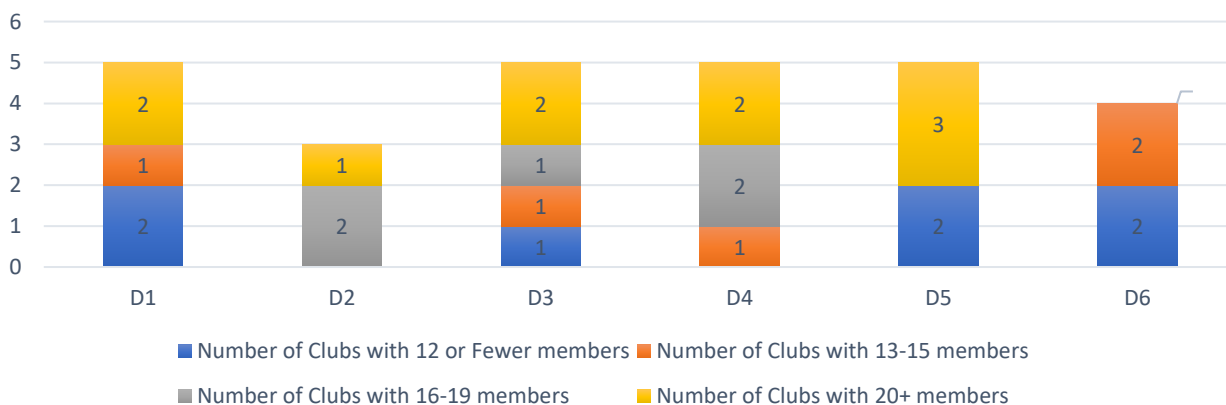
Overall Club Health has increased across many areas, with several clubs moving up a tier and some going above 20+ members for the first time in years.

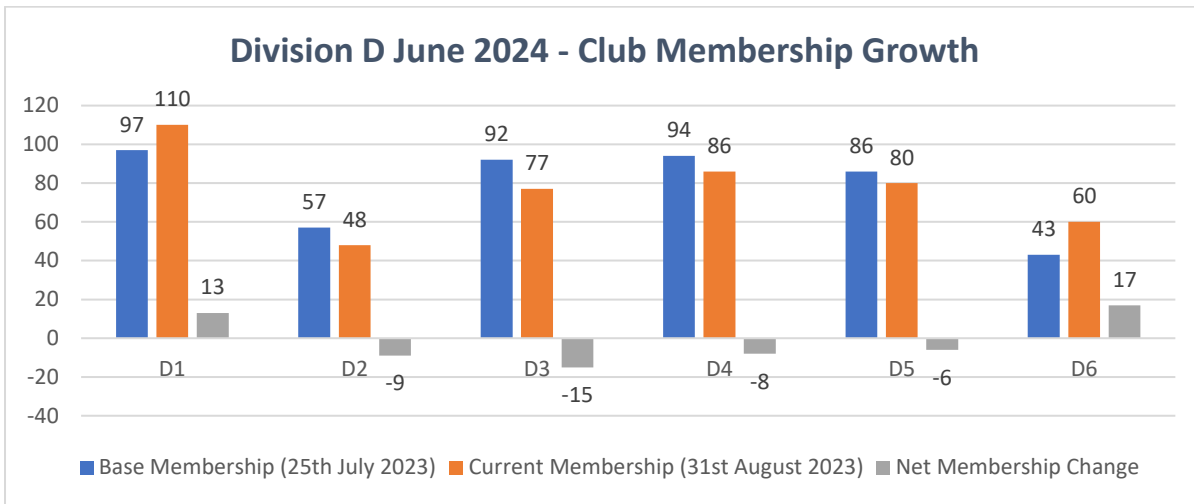
Congratulations to Madhatter’s Club – growing from 11 to 24 members across the year is quite an achievement!

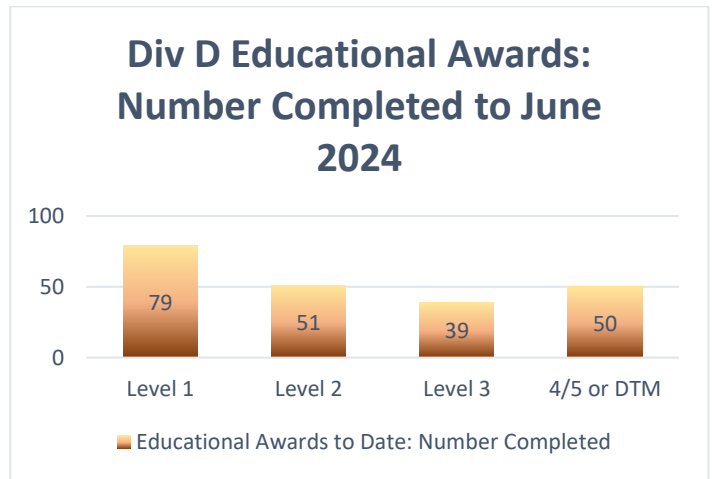
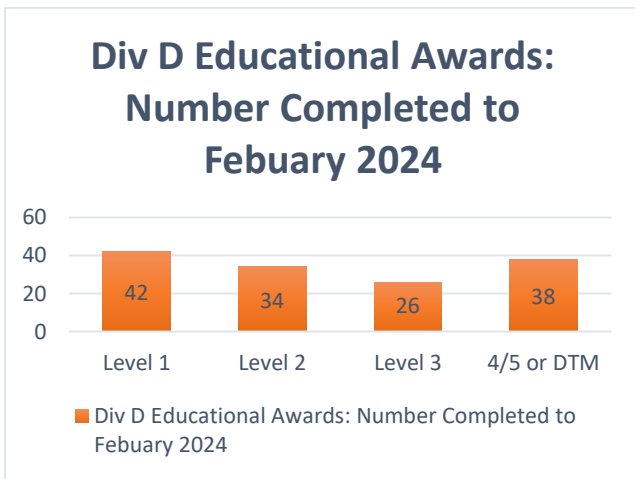
